NOTICE OF RACE

1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The race is organised and conducted by SAF Yacht Club (SAFYC) under the auspices of the Singapore Sailing Federation.
- 1.12 The SAFYC invites entries from boats for the Club's signature keelboat race, the Horsburgh Challenge.
- 1.13 Owners and charterers of eligible boats are invited to apply for entry on the conditions of this notice of race.
- 1.14 The race will begin from SAFYC to the Horsburgh Lighthouse on the first day. This is a Category 3 race. The second day will see the race being conducted off the East Coast Park. And last day will be windward / leeward course racing off the waterfront of SAFYC Changi Clubhouse.

2 RACE

- 2.1 The start and finish will be within in the vicinity just off the SAFYC marina.

3 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

3.1 The organising authority is the SAFYC.

4 RULES

4.1 General

The race will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2005 – 2008 (RRS) and the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972 (as amended) (Collisions Regulations).

Between sunset and sunrise, RRS sections A, B, C and D will cease to apply and will be replaced by the Collisions Regulations.

4.2 Notice to Competitors

Notice to the competitors will be posted on the official notice boards located at the Regatta Office marked Horsburgh Challenge Official Notice board. The Regatta Office will be at SAF Yacht Club (Changi Clubhouse)

4.3 Sailing Instructions (SI)

The SI will be published on the race's website and issued at the skipper's briefing. Thereafter, the SI will be available upon request.

4.4 Scoring

The low point system, Appendix A4, in the Racing Rules of Sailing will apply. Double weightage points will be applied to race 1 and it cannot be discarded in the overall scoring.

5 ELIGIBILITY

5.1 A boat shall be:

- Any self-righting mono-hulled sailing boat.

5.2 IRC Class

Yachts participating in the IRC Class shall have a valid IRC 2007 Certificate.

PY Class

Yachts of a cruising nature will be assigned an arbitrary PY number by the Handicapping Committee. PY numbers assigned by the Handicapping Committee shall be final.

5.3 A decision by the organising authority as to any matters under this clause is final and binding.

5.4 Checks may be carried out on boats to confirm that the number of crew on board are as stated in the entry form, that safety equipment are in order. Boats found to be in contravention of any of the requirements may not be allowed to race, disqualified or penalised.

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6 ENTRY FORMS AND FEES

6.1 Interested participants may obtain an entry form from the organising authority via the following means:

6.2 The following documentation are to be submitted with the entry form:
- A copy of at least a Third Party Insurance
- For a yacht participating in the IRC Class, a copy of the valid 2007 IRC certificate (refer to paragraph 6.4)

6.3 Entries must be made on the official form and be received by 20th January 2008. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the organisers.

The following fees shall be paid to the organising authority by cheque, credit card, Nets or member's account (applicable to members of the SAF Yacht Club only):

Per boat including skipper	S\$160.00
Per additional crew member as nominated on the application for entry	S\$32.00

Members of SAF Yacht Club whose boats are berthed at either one of the SAFYC Marinas will only need to pay 50% of the boat entry fee.

6.4 After the submission of a boat's valid IRC rating certificate, it may be amended by notifying the organising authority not later than 26th January 2008.

7 PRIZES

7.1 Race 1 – 1st, 2nd, 3rd & Line Honours for IRC, PY & One Design class.
Race 2 – 1st, 2nd & 3rd for IRC, PY & One Design class.
Race 3 to 5 – 1st, 2nd & 3rd for IRC, PY & One Design class overall
Overall Champion – 1st, 2nd & 3rd for IRC, PY & One Design class.

7.2 The overall champion yacht of the IRC Class shall be recorded in the Chief of Defence Force Cup (CDF Cup), and the overall champion yacht of the PY Class shall be recorded in the PY Challenge Trophy.

8 ADVERTISING

8.1 The race is designated as a Category C event in accordance with the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2005 – 2008).

8.2 Boats may be required to display the race's sponsors' advertising in accordance with NOR clause 8.1.

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9 SAFETY

- 9.1 The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/skipper. All locally licensed boats must comply with at least the Maritime & Port Authority (MPA) regulations. The ISAF Special Regulations for Race Category 3 is recommended, but not compulsory. Every owner/skipper warrants the suitability of his/her boat for the race.
- 9.2 The race officials' boats may be positioned at strategic locations during the race. Procedures for reporting position and status to the Radio Relay Vessel will be listed in the SI and advised at the skippers' briefing.
- 9.3 A compulsory skippers' briefing is scheduled on 25th January 2008, 1900hrs at the SAF Yacht Club, Changi Clubhouse. It is recommended that the skipper or navigator attend or at least two crew members from each boat.

10 CIQP

- 10.1 All participating boats are responsible for their own inbound and outbound immigration and port clearance before and after the race as applicable.
- 10.2 Skippers are to note that for Race 1, port and immigration clearance are required for the passage race to Horsburgh Lighthouse. The port and immigration clearing out and in and out will be arranged by the SAFYC at Changi Club House.
- 10.3 Skippers should submit all relevant documentation for port and immigration clearance when registering their boats including the boat crew list, for purpose of port and immigration clearance as per para 10.2. Skippers are to note that every individual crew member must be present during the immigration / port clearance.

11 BERTHING

- 11.1 Berthing for participating boats only will be at SAF Yacht Club, Changi Clubhouse's marina. Berthing for participants is free of charge from 19 January 2008 to 24th February 2008. Participating boats' owners/skippers will be advised of their berth when the Regatta Secretariat acknowledges their entry. There will be no up-slip of boats.

12 INSURANCE

- 12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with at least a third party liability insurance. A copy of the certificate of insurance or cover note valid for a period of the race shall be submitted with the entry form and the original may be checked at the point of registration.

13 DISCLAIMER

- 13.1 Competitors participating in the race do so entirely at their own risk. The decision to participate in this race or to continue racing lies solely with the skipper/owner. (See RRS rule 4, Decision to race.) The organising authority, officials, sponsors, volunteers, staff and supporting agencies will not accept any liability for material damages or losses, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the race.
