SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at National Sailing Centre.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1230hrs on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800hrs on the day before it will take effect.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag staff located at the boatpark.
- 5 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in race signal AP.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 Dates of racing:

31 January 2009	Racing	1 st warning signal at 1430 hrs
1 February 2009	Racing	1 st warning signal at 1300 hrs
- 6.2 There will be no limit to the number of races per day.
- 6.3 On the last day of the race no warning signal will be made after **1500hrs.**

7 CLASS FLAGS

7.1 The class flags will be:

<i>Class</i>	<i>Flag</i>
Optimist	Black letter 'OPT' on yellow backing
Byte	Black letter 'BYTE' on dark purple backing

8 RACING AREAS

8.1 Racing area will be at sea front outside National Sailing Centre.

9 THE COURSES

9.1 The diagrams in Attachment 1 show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

9.2 A race committee boat signalling a change of a leg of the course is a mark as provided in instruction 12.

10 MARKS

10.1 Marks 1, 2, 3 & 4 will be pink spherical marks.

10.2 The starting mark will be a yellow spherical buoy.

10.3 The finishing mark will be a blue spherical buoy.

11 THE START

11.1 Races will be started using rule 26, with the warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal.

11.2 The starting line will be between the race committee signal boat and the starting mark.

11.3 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes rule A4.

12 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

12.1 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will either move the original mark to a new position or lay a new mark and remove the original mark as soon as practicable. When in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark.

13 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be the race committee signal boat displaying a **blue flag** and the finishing mark.

14 TIME LIMITS

14.1 Time Limits are as follows:

<i>Class</i>	<i>Time Limit</i>
Optimist/Byte	40 minutes

14.2 Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes or within the time limit, whichever is the later, will be scored Did Not Finish. This changes rules 35 and A4.1.

15 SCORING

15.1 A maximum of 7 races are scheduled.

- (a) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score in that fleet shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (b) There is no maximum number of races per day.

16 SAFETY REGULATIONS

16.1 **Buoyancy:** All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times whilst afloat.

16.2 **Check-out and check-in:** Each boat shall personally sign-on on the forms provided at the Race Office prior to launching for the first race of the day. After arriving on shore, each boat shall personally sign-off on the forms provided within the protest time limit.

16.3 A boat failing to comply with instruction 16.2 may be protested by the race committee. The penalty is a DSQ in the first race of the day.

17 TRASH DISPOSAL

Boats shall not put trash in the water. Trash may be placed aboard support and race committee boats.

18 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

19 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

19.1 Optimist

Advanced 'A'	1 st - 3 rd
Advanced 'B'	1 st - 3 rd
Advanced 'C'	1 st - 3 rd
Overall	1 st

19.2 Byte

Byte Sailing Squad	1 st - 2 nd
Byte Intermediate	1 st - 2 nd
Byte Advanced	1 st - 2 nd
Overall	1 st

20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.

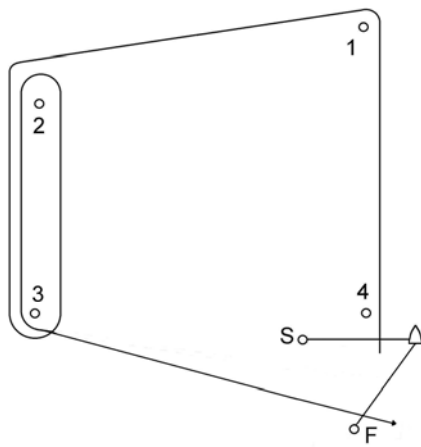
21 INSURANCE

Start, Mark 1, Mark 4, Mark 1, Mark 4, Mark 1, Mark 2, Mark 3, Finish

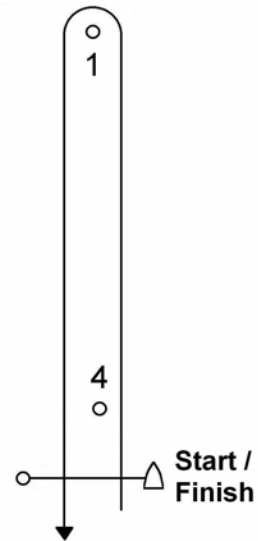
Course Flag "O1" (Outer Loop – 1 lap)
