NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 Class Rule C.1.2.1 will apply for 420 class.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all sailors in the Laser, Laser Radial, Byte, Bic Techno, RS:X and 420 classes, who are members of a club affiliated to SingaporeSailing or in the case of international entrants, are members of a club affiliated to their own national authority.
- 3.2 Singaporean 420 competitors must have at least SingaporeSailing Level 2 Proficiency certification. All other Singaporean competitors in the other classes must have at least SingaporeSailing Level 1 Proficiency certification.
- 3.3 Proof of club membership is required upon submission of entry form. Sailors without valid club membership shall not be eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to

- 3.5 Late registration will be closed one day before the regatta date at 1600.

- 3.6 The Organising Authority may accept the late registration at its own discretion and to be subjected to a late entry fee.
- 3.7 A minimum of 6 entries in each class is required to form an event.

4 FEES

5 NSC CUP SERIES

The NSC Cup is comprised of 3 individual series of races which will be conducted on the following weekends:

- (a) Series 1: 27 – 28 Feb 2010
- (b) Series 2: 10 – 11 July 2010
- (c) Series 3: 6 – 7 Nov 2010

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 Racing is from 10 – 11 July 2010.
- 6.2 The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first race each day is 1100.
- 6.1 There will be no limit to the number of races that may be sailed per day.
- 6.2 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 1530.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after the closing date at the National Sailing Centre.

8 VENUE

Attachment 1 shows the location of the racing areas.

9 THE COURSES

The courses will be as follows:

Course Alpha - Byte and Laser: Trapezoid

Course Bravo - 420 and Windsurfing class: Windward/Leeward

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 Appendix P will apply as changed by instructions 10.2 and 10.3.
- 10.2 On the first protest, if a boat is protested after she has finished, she will be given a scoring penalty of 6 points, without a hearing. If her score results in a score worse than DSQ, the penalty will be corresponding to DSQ.
- 10.3 Rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.
- 10.4 For the Windsurfing class, Rule 44.2 is changed so that two turns are replaced by one 360° turn with no requirement for tacks or gybes.
- 10.5 Action taken under Appendix P will not be grounds for redress by a competitor.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 A maximum of 5 races are scheduled for each individual NSC Cup series.
- 11.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute an individual series.
 - (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3 A maximum of 15 races are scheduled for the NSC Cup for each class.
 - (a) When fewer than 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from 7 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores.
 - (c) When 11 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as stated below for the NSC Cup Series. Prizes may also be awarded for each individual series at the conclusion of the respective individual series.
